

Uruguay Guerilla Killed in Clash

A Tupamaro guerilla was killed and another was captured in a gun fight with soldiers near the Uruguay-Brazilian frontier, authorities reported.

They said two soldiers were wounded in the battle Sunday night and an intense search is under way in the Rivera district for other Tupamaros believed to be in the area.

The slain guerilla was identified as Juan Diogenes Alvarez Miranda. Captured was Nicolas Esteves Fernandez, who had escaped with 106 other Tupamaros from Montevideo's Punta Carretas Prison in September.
