## Arrests avert assassinations

MONTEVIDEO, URUGUAY (AP) — Sixty-two leftists arrested by security agents planned to assassinate several high officials and blow up ships in Montevideo harbor, a military communique said Friday.

The alleged plot was reported 24 hours after the military-controlled government announced the capture of the suspects and said they belonged to a terrorist organization called Party for the People's Victory (PVP).

It claimed the PVP is based in Buenos Aires, Argentina, across the River Plate from Montevideo.
